Detentions are held 3:30 pm until 4:30 pm.

Are unsafe/ dangerous in your behaviour. Bully – i.e. repeated verbal, physical, cyber abuse. Have extreme hairstyles. Break exam hall rules. You have accumulated 12 faults in your fault log. Miss lessons, go off-site or out of bounds without permission from Senior Staff. Use any device in breach of the Academy Acceptable Use Policy. Repeated use of a mobile phone. Wear incorrect uniform - including correct shoes. Wear banned items of clothing and refuse to follow instructions. 	C4 'Isolation' Letter Home	 The Consequences Hierarchy is written and signed by you. Report card issued and HOY/Tutor informed. You will be isolated for a suitable length of time. This will include losing break/lunch. This maybe for a few periods or several days depending on the seriousness of your offence. Note: Once in the Isolation Room there will be no unnecessary talking and the session will be repeated if rules are not followed/ insufficient work is completed. Tobacco will be confiscated and needs to be collected by parents. Do the exam in isolation.
 Smoke on the Academy campus or a school Trip (including e-cigarettes). Undertake premeditated ongoing extreme bullying of any kind. Assault someone/use violence. Bring a weapon to Academy. Persistently defy school rules and miss sanctions. Swear or are abusive to adults or prefects either verbally or in written form. Are persistently given a C4. Steal. or vandalise. Commit forgery. Commit an equalities act offence to a person on the grounds of race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, religion, physical or mental ability, age or physical appearance.
